Safety

First and foremost please remember this is a public venue and that all children should be under the supervision of an adult.

Drop Off /Pick Up

Although parents are not required to stay at practice for the entire session it is imperative that you know your child is under the supervision of a coach before leaving the facility. To ensure this we ask that when dropping your child off for practice that you bring them into the pool facility. Please wait for your child to be under the supervision of a coach for the designated time of their specific practice before leaving. We also would like these same guidelines followed when picking your child up at practice as well. Please come into the pool facility so that when swimmers are dismissed the coaching staff can feel confident that each child has an adult waiting for them when leaving the building. Please remember this is a public venue and these requirements are for the safety of our children.

Behavior & Conduct

As guests of Connecticut College it is extremely important that all people entering the facility affiliated with Camel Swim Club conduct themselves in the most appropriate manner at all times. It is critical that we respect the facility, staff, students and property at all times. No running, horse play or disorderly conduct will be tolerated. Small children need constant supervision. It is our first priority to ensure the safety of all affiliates of Camel Swim Club. Therefore, it is crucial that these guidelines are implemented and taken seriously.
