- Schedule: 4:15PM warm-up, 5:00PM start
- Eligibility: All participants must be 2008 USA Swimming registered. Out of state teams must submit a roster of swimmers signed by the LSC registration chairman or other acceptable proof that each swimmer is registered. The swimmer's age as of May 18 will determine the age for the meet.
- Entry Format: Seed times should be submitted in SCY. Teams should submit their entries via e-mail. Entries in Hy-Tek or SDIF will be accepted. Please send your entry to coachann@camelswim.org as an attachment. If any of your swimmers are swimming the meet unattached please mark **UN** clearly in **RED** along side of the swimmer's name on the entry sheet. All events will be seeded according to the swimmers' best yard times. NT entries are strongly discouraged; please estimate times.
- Deadline: Entries must be received by **10:00PM, Thursday, May 8.**
- Entry Fees: \$ 1.00 per individual event, \$ 2.00 per relay.
Please make checks payable to **Camel Swim Club.**
- Limitations: Swimmers may swim a maximum of five (5) events per day. This is an invitational meet, please contact the meet director if you are interested in attending.
- Credentials: All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming coach Card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of the meet..
- Scratch Sheets: Scratch sheets must be completed and returned to the computer table 20 minutes after the start of the first warm-up.
- Workers: All teams will be required to provide meet workers (timers and/or officials) in proportion to the size of their team entry. Meet workers are required to continue to fulfill their assigned duties until the conclusion of the session regardless if their team has anyone entered in the remaining heats.
- Officials: Certified officials interested in working at the meet should include their name and contact information with their team's entry and/or contact the meet referee, Bob Hughes, at hughes4@cox.net or the Meet Director at coachann@camelswim.org. Officials who commit to work a session(s) before May 13 will be counted towards their team's work assignment.
- Awards: There will be small surprise awards.
- Hospitality: There will be a hospitality room for coaches and officials located in the team room adjacent to the pool office with snacks and beverages.
- Facility: Lott Natatorium houses an eight lane pool with a warm-up/warm-down well and a Daktronics electronic timing system. The pool is handicap accessible. For specific needs, please contact the Meet Director.

Parking: Ample parking is available in the lot in front of the natatorium, to the north side of the ice rink and in the back (east side). Parking must be in marked spaces only. Please do not block other vehicles. Parking is NOT permitted on the access roads or grass areas. Handicap parking is available.

Directions: From Hartford and points north: Take I-84 East to Route 2 East to I-395 South (exit 28S). Proceed approximately 8 miles to Route 32 South (exit 78 which is a left exit). Continue on Route 32 South about 1 mile. After you pass under the pedestrian bridge, turn left at the light into the Charles B. Luce Field House / Dayton Arena Natatorium parking area for athlete drop-off and pick up of parking map.

From New York and points south: Take I-95 North to Exit 83. Make a left at the light at the end of the exit. Go to the next light and turn right past the entrance to the US Coast Guard Academy onto Route 32 North. Turn right at the third light. You will see a sign for the Charles B. Luce Field House /Dayton Arena Natatorium parking area for athlete drop-off and pick up of parking map. Directions may also be accessed via the CAMEL website: www.camelswim.org
